<p>Monday, April 8, 2019</p>	<p>Announcements start for Mandatory Meeting for Student Council/SAC President/Vice-President Candidates on April 15, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Grade 12 Student Council President - Grade 11 Student Council President - Grade 12 SAC President - Grade 11 SAC Vice-President - Grade 10 SAC Vice-President
<p>Monday, April 15, 2019</p>	<p>Mandatory Meeting for Student Council/SAC President/Vice-President Candidates – review requirements, hand out application packages, and ensure they understand that the supplementary documentation (<i>Constitution section 8.8</i>) is due at the Mandatory Meeting for ALL Student Council/SAC candidates on Tuesday, April 23, 2019.</p> <p>Anyone who wishes to run for one of these presidential positions but is unable to attend the meeting MUST contact Mrs. Andrews, Ms. Sormaz, and Ms. Trowsdale BEFORE the meeting with an explanation as to why they cannot attend, and to find out the requirements for running.</p>
<p>Tuesday, April 23, 2019</p>	<p>Mandatory Meeting for ALL Student Council/SAC candidates.</p> <p>Supplemental documentation (300-500 word statement OR 1 page reference letter) due for all President/Vice-President candidates.</p> <p>Hand out application packages for all other positions.</p> <p>Anyone who wishes to run for any position, but is unable to attend the meeting, MUST contact Mrs. Andrews, Ms. Sormaz, and Ms. Trowsdale BEFORE the meeting with an explanation as to why they cannot attend, and to find out the requirements for running.</p>

During the next 5 (minimum) weekdays, Student Council and SAC Staff Advisors and Administration will meet to discuss the supplemental documentation submitted by President/Vice-President candidates to ensure they meet expectations with regard to leadership experience.

As per the Constitution, only those nominees for President and Vice-President positions whose applications have been approved by the Student Council and SAC Staff Advisor(s) and School Administration as having sufficient relevant leadership experience shall be able to campaign for a President or Vice-President position.

Wednesday, May 1, 2019	All application packages due in full. It is the responsibility of the candidate to follow up with teachers to ensure Teacher Reference Forms are submitted on time.
Thursday, May 2, 2019	Campaigning begins It is the responsibility of the candidate to have their campaigning materials approved by school administration before it goes up. Any unapproved and/or inappropriate campaigning materials will be removed without warning. Tampering with the campaigning materials of another candidate will result in the culprit being immediately disqualified from the election. No social media or online campaigning is permitted.
Friday, May 10, 2019	All campaign materials must be down by 4 pm
Monday, May 13, 2019	Election day (Period 1)
